

# Browsing a project

The project browser has three panels:

- On the left is the Hierarchy tree. Here you can browse through concepts/classes - click on it to display its details.
- In the panel is the details panel. This will show the full description of the class/concept selected in the hierarchy tree.
- On the right is the search panel, use this to [search for classes/concepts](#).
